## Laity of the Chevalier Family Logo

The Laity of the Chevalier Family (LCF) logo was designed at the Third International Assembly of Laity of the Chevalier Family in 2017. Differing from the explicitly Christian images of the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart (MSC), the Daughters of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart (FDNSC/OLSH Sisters), and the Missionary Sisters of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus (MSC Sisters), this logo points to the lay charism, where we live in families, earn our living in our communities, and commit ourselves differently to the professed members. Additionally, the logo links to foundational scriptures: It is in him (LOVE) that we live and move and exist (Acts 17:28), this LOVE of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit (Romans 5:5), and whoever fails to LOVE does not know God, because God is LOVE (1 Jn 4: 8).


