Father Jules Chevalier was driven by the conviction that God's love, revealed in the heart of Jesus, is boundless and unconditional - God is loving, not harsh.

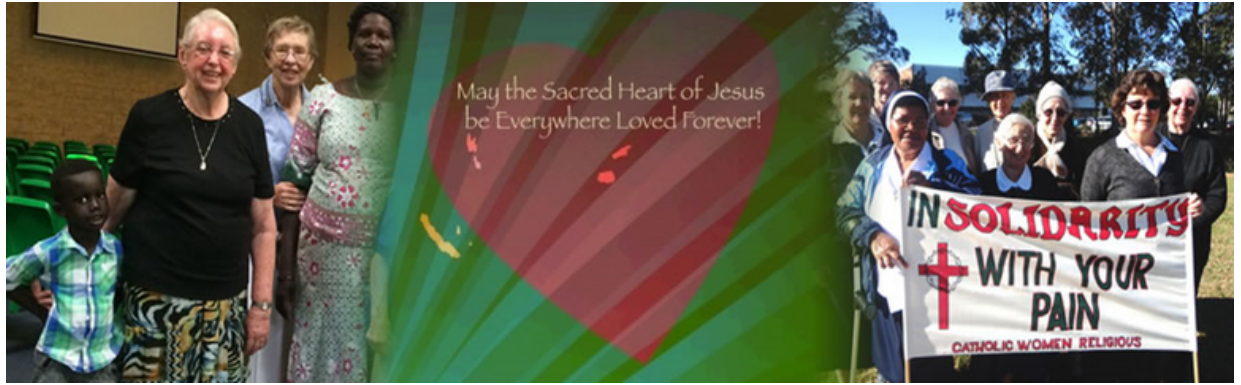
God's love includes every person, regardless of who we are, where we are, what we have done, or what may have happened to us.
