Australian Council Retreat

"One Heart Spirituality, Many Paths" 20-22 January 2023 Kensington, NSW

The retreat began on Friday with a beautiful reflection by Sandy Abbey with a presentation on Cuskelly's view of Spirituality of the Heart. 
Sunday was spent in Eucharist and planning for 2023, followed by a superb reflection by Kerrie Wehbe to end the retreat.
