

NAIDOC Week


The Chevalier Family celebrated NAIDOC Week from 2 - 9 July 2023, which aims "to celebrate and recognise the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples" (NAIDOC). This year's theme, 'For Our Elders', recognises their important and prominent place as "cultural knowledge holders, trailblazers, nurturers, advocates, teachers, survivors, leaders, hard workers and our loved ones... They guide our generations and pave the way for us to take the paths we can take today. Guidance, not only through generations of advocacy and activism but in everyday life and how to place ourselves in the world. We draw strength from their knowledge and experience". (NAIDOC) Pope Francis reminds us that Elders are "a precious treasure that preserves a history greater than themselves" and "it is essential to cultivate our roots, to pray for and with our forbears, to dedicate time to remember and guard their legacy. 




Encounter of Hearts

First Friday Reflection

The International Chevalier Family publishes a First Friday reflection to support individuals and groups to focus communally on an area of spiritual formation. It aims to raise awareness, inspire prayer, and give a social justice action related to the monthly topic. The initiative is jointly supported by the International Laity of the Chevalier Family, the Daughters of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart, the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart, and the Missionary Sisters of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Australian Reflection

The paper, Ecological Virtues in Laudato Si, highlights "praise, gratitude, care, justice, work, sobriety, and humility" as the key ecological virtues. It states: "We will save our common home only when we learn to see it with a deep sense of wonder that wells up in spontaneous praise of the Creator for all the marvels of creation". It reminds us to imitate First Nations people's gratitude using Pope Francis' words: "For them, the land is not a commodity but rather a gift from God and from their ancestors who rest there, a sacred space with which they need to interact if they are to maintain their identity and values". When we care, we have a "view of the world as a network of relationships", and can "set before the world the ideal of a 'civilisation of love". If "the earth is essentially a shared inheritance, who fruits are meant to benefit everyone", then we must act justly, not only "between communities of the same human generation (intragenerational)" but also "between current and future generations (inter-generational)". As we celebrate NAIDOC Week "For Our Elders", we are reminded to draw on the wisdom of those who lived harmoniously with Country for over 60,000 years.

Sacred Heart Feast Celebrations

The Chevalier Family celebrated the Feast of the Sacred Heart on 16 June 2023.

As the Chevalier Family, we strive 'to be on Earth the Heart of God'. On the Feast of the Sacred Heart, we reflect on the depths of God's heart and the gift of 'Spirituality of the Heart'. We celebrate what 'being' God's heart means to ourselves and those we live with (our families, friends, workplaces, communities, and all Creation).


I thank my God, each time I think of you. And when I pray for you, I pray with joy.
